Goalie clinics

- Board has heard complaints about new format for goalie clinics, that there are less this year than last and why?
- Mike F. clarified that this year the board decided to have Ed Walsh work with each teams coaches to have a goalie coach at each practice, that goalies are getting more instruction this way rather than just the one on one at Ed Walsh's.
- parents raised concern that other programs give more incentives to have goalies in their program
- Joe K. pointed out that the cost per player for skills is \$40. the cost per goalie was \$550 and the goalies also get skating time as players. The board was attempting to bring the cost in line.
- idea of a goalie coordinator was raised to make sure parents and goalies get communication about the programs and to make sure each team is implementing the goalie coach skills.
